

## **THE BILL OF CATS**

### Article 1.

All cats are born free and equal.

### Article 2.

The rights and freedoms of cats can not be set depending on their breed, color, sexual habits and other things. The presence of upholstered furniture, Christmas tree or fragile objects in the house should also not limit the rights and freedoms of cats.

### Article 3.

It is forbidden to treat a cat as a thing including using a cat as a towel, using a cat as a bast and using a cat for production of static electricity.

### Article 4.

Nobody has to be beaten by a slipper or by any other subject

### Article 5.

The only document confirming the status of a cat are his whiskers, paws and tail.

### Article 6.

The untidy cat's tray automatically justifies wet slippers. Also nobody can be punished for a slipper which at the time of action hadn't belonged to the person who is living together with cat.

### Article 7.

No cat should be exposed to compulsory caress. It is forbidden to use the social status and physical superiority to caress a cat despite its will.

### Article 8.

Every cat has the right to walk independently.

### Article 9.

The cat's shelter under a blanket is inviolable except for cases of wet slippers which are documentary confirmed.

Article 10.

Every cat has the right for its own man, as well as the right to change him.

Article 11.

Cats have the right to love other cats without any limitation. Family values of a cat are essential. They can only be cut off for the sake of saving life and well-being of a cat.

Article 12.

Every cat has the right to learn oneself and other cats in any convenient way.

Article 13.

Every cat has the right for free creative activities and access to unattended cultural values.

Article 14.

The cat's bowl is the main factor of social progress and is in the zone of special attention.
